Sermon Notes

Grace – undeserved, divine assistance given by God for the purpose of *salvation, sanctification, and regeneration*

Salvation – deliverance from the *power and penalty* of sin

Sanctification – to *make holy*

Regeneration – spiritual renewal (revival)

Verse 13 – You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away.

- **Dead** – [Greek *nekros*] _____

- Without Christ you _____ but you are not _____.
- ✓ It is not necessary to “get right” because He takes you as you are.

Verse 14 – He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross.

- Cancel – Expunge _____

- Everything in your past that Satan seeks to hold against you (including the worst thing(s) that you have ever done) God cancels.
 - ✓ Therefor you don't have the right to _____ anything God says is _____ . – YOU ARE FORGIVEN!!
